INTRODUCTION

ACCCT is pleased to announce the introduction of the Experience Rating Worksheet Lookup product, which was specifically designed to provide access to Experience Rating Worksheets through ACCCT's CDX Internet application. This product provides extensive search criteria and sort criteria to allow the user to find, view, and print ratings.

Experience Rating Worksheets are available from the following Data Collection Organizations (DCOs): Delaware, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin. Additionally, ACCCT has provided a link to the California and New York web sites for access to their Experience Rating Worksheets.

The new Experience Rating Worksheet Lookup product is available at no additional charge to current DCO member insurers in good standing.

HOW EXPERIENCE RATING WORKSHEET LOOKUP WILL WORK

For security reasons, member insurers will only be able to view and/or retrieve their own worksheets. User functions are provided so each rating selected can be viewed, and can be printed using the browser print function.

HOW TO GET STARTED

Access to Experience Rating Worksheet Lookup is provided through ACCCT's Compensation Data Exchange (CDX) system. ACCCT has established a *Central Administrator* to process all applications and establish accounts for all member insurers who desire to use the CDX system. You may contact the Central Administrator or the ACCCT representative(s) at the appropriate DCO(s) as shown below for additional information or to receive an application.
