RE: NCCI Proposal Item B-1410 Revision to Basic Manual Classifications & Appendix E – Classifications by Hazard Group

Pursuant to ch 626, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin, Office of the Commissioner of Insurance has advised that the action taken by the Governing Board has been approved.

The following revisions are approved effective October 1, 2011, applicable for new and renewal business only:

1. Carpentry Shop

- Discontinue code 2812 Cabinet Works-With Power Machinery and combine the exposure with code 2883 Furniture Mfg-Wood-NOC.

The experience for both codes 2812 and 2883 will be combined to produce the effective rate for 2883.

The following changes to the class code phraseologies are proposed:

2. Manufactured, Modular Homes Manufacturing

- Adopt the proposal to create code 2797 for the manufacture of both mobile homes and modular homes.

The initial rate for 2797 will be that of code 3824 until 2797 establishes sufficient experience to develop its own rate.

This classification applies to insureds that manufacture or fabricate manufactured, modular, or prefabricated homes at a factory site only. Manufactured homes are also known as mobile homes. Framing can be done with wood or metal studs.

Manufacture of masonry or concrete modular building (built in a shop, transported to the site, and set in place) must be separately rated.

This classification includes the manufacturing of nonmotorized construction, home-type, medical, and bank trailers, and similar portable buildings; campers that are set on pickup trucks; and truck sleepers that are mounted behind the cab of semi trucks. It includes installation or repair of the before-mentioned products assembled at the factory site only.

This classification also includes delivery performed by the manufacturer. Delivery from an outside trucking company must be separately rated to the appropriate trucking classification. Setup, hookup, installation, or finish work at a job site must be separately rated.

3. Manufactured Homes Setup

- Adopt the proposal to create code 2799 for the setup and installation of mobile homes, modular homes and prefabricated homes.
- Expand the scope of code 6400 to include the construction of fences produced from materials other than metal, including wood and vinyl.

The rate for 2799 will be developed by initially applying a weighting of the experience for codes 8391 and 5403 until such time that 2799 establishes sufficient experience to develop its own rate. Specifically, the weight applied to the experience for 8391 will be 75% while the weight applied to the experience of 5403 will be 25%.
