RE: Non-Ratable Classifications – Minimum Premium

Amendment to Circular Letter 3042 - October 1, 2009 Rate Revision

Wisconsin has three classification codes which have a sister code for the reporting of the non-ratable portion of the rate. The non-ratable portion is defined as a supplementary loading or percentage included in the development of the manual rate for a particular classification. It adjusts for the classification's potential for occupational disease or catastrophic losses. Both codes must be shown on the policy. The non-ratable codes are:

For Reporting Non-Ratable Portion of Rate for Code 4771
For Reporting Non-Ratable Portion of Rate for Code 7405
For Reporting Non-Ratable Portion of Rate for Code 7431

When calculating the minimum premium for codes 4771, 7405 and 7431 the data for the non-ratable codes was excluded. Code 4771 was already capped at \$900 so no correction was required. The following amendments have been approved by the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance and are effective 10-1-09:
