"This Committee meeting has been called to discuss the items of mutual interest and concern to the members of the Wisconsin Compensation Rating Bureau. In accordance with both Federal and Wisconsin State Anti-trust Laws, this Committee is prohibited from any discussion or action which constitutes any form of boycott, coercion, or intimidation."

A Special Rating Committee meeting was called to discuss the October 1, 2010 rate filing. The following items were recommended by the Rating Committee:

- Adopt trend factors recommended by the Actuarial Subcommittee.
- Propose an overall increase in rate level of 3.46%.
