RE: Class Code Changes Effective 10-1-10

Circular Letters 3036 dated November 24, 2008 and 3038 dated April 27, 2009 announced several revisions to the WI Basic Manual Classifications. The following is a list of changes. New language is underlined, eliminated language is struck through. In addition to the primary phraseology, only the changes have been identified.
