RE: Code 2211

The Office of the Commissioner of insurance approved the recommendation of the Governing Board to eliminate Class Code 2211 for use in Wisconsin and reassign exposure to code 2300 effective 10-1-11 for new and renewal business. The Wisconsin Basic Manual will be amended as follows:
